Vaccines provide life saving benefits by protecting your pet from many diseases and should be a part of routine preventative health care for all cats. At 5 Points Animal Hospital, we carefully choose our vaccines based on their known effectiveness and safety and also strive to tailor our vaccine protocol to the individual patient based on life stage, environment, life style, risk of exposure to disease and underlying medical conditions.

The American Animal Hospital Association has published guidelines for vaccinations in dogs and cats; vaccines are divided into two categories - **CORE** and **NON-CORE**. **CORE** vaccines are those that should be given to every patient, regardless of environment and lifestyle. **CORE** vaccines include **RABIES, FVCRP FELINE PANLEUKOPENIA (FELINE DISTEMPER), CALICIVRUS, and HERPES (FELINE VIRAL RHINOTRACHEITIS).**

The **PUREVAX FELINE RABIES VACCINE** is offered as either a 1 year or a 3 year vaccination.
